Jamnagar, Gujrat

All beneficiaries including widows and orphans were visited to assess their currents situation and eligibility for monthly subsidiaries. Further 12 new applicants, including, widows, a physically disadvantage child and underprivileged families with no source of income were accepted for financial aid on a monthly basis. Families requiring this assistance had family members who were terminally ill, mentally and physically disadvantaged, therefore, requiring much attention at home making it extremely difficult to earn a liable income.

Dwarka, Gujrat

This year, an eye camp was set up where 218 patient's visited, from which more than 50 patients required cataract operations and over 120 patients required spectacles. As part of the eye camp package, aftercare treatment including eye drops and medication was included to treat the patients.



India Project Feedback 2015

With the grace of Almighty Allah SWT, 100s of poverty stricken families, individuals and children spanning in major areas of India were provided with humanitarian aid and relief ranging from:

- **+**Construction of water wells
- *Food aid
- *Clothing donation

Moirabari, Assam

There are 450 girls boarding at the Assam Madressa living in poorly constructed dilapidated sheds. As the area is prone to flooding, preventative measures have taken place including laying floor protectors with goals to rebuild the Madressa to a good liveable standard. So far 450 blankets and nonperishable food have been donated to students.

Rampur, Bihar

Several madressas in Bihar were visited and In Sha Allah we hope to work with one of them to improve the living and learning conditions for the students. This madressa institutes 250 students including one devoted blind girl on the Hafidh Programme.



2016 Targets

- *Installation of 30 water wells in individual homes including 1 at Assam Madressa
- *Continue monthly subsidiaries to **100** beneficiaries
- *Provide **sewing machines** to women in financially unstable families in order to create income opportunities
- *Complete medical programme including operations and aftercare treatment
- *Jamnagar: Continue sponsoring 375 students at Jamnagar Madressa, providing Sadaqas, Aqqiqa and Qurbanis
- *Moirabari: Rebuild Assam Madressa and continue providing non-perishable food and sponsoring 450 students at Assam Madressa
- *Rampur: Continue sponsoring blind young girl on Hafidh Programme, rebuild kitchen in Bihar Madressa and continue sponsoring 250 students on Hafidh Programme, providing food aid
