



Disposal of Rubbish/Recycling (*not as you may know it!*)

All local councils have their own recycling and waste system as environmentally it is important that we recycle our waste, along with the fact that Tunbridge Wells Council will fine us heavily if we don't - and we wouldn't want that? - would we?

General Waste

Your general waste is for household rubbish that cannot be recycled or composted. For example, disposable nappies, food trays and yoghurt pots (large kitchen bin to main general waste bin in front courtyard)

Food Waste

Your food waste bin is for any compostable food waste (green kitchen caddy to main brown compost bin in front courtyard).

Recycling Boxes

In the kitchen you will find recycling boxes for paper & cardboard, plastics & tins. Please ensure you put the contents of these boxes into the relevant main bins in the front courtyard. **The glass recycling goes into the green box alongside these bins.**

The local council collect waste and recycle on a fortnightly cycle, therefore please ensure your rubbish is cleanly and properly bagged and put into Hoppers bins in the front court yard, any other bins are not ours.
