



Fire Safety Instructions For Visitors

To help make your stay at Hoppers safe please ensure these fire safety instructions are read.

- 1) Before going to bed everyone should make sure they know the different routes downstairs and out of the building. Please note the fire exit doors and work out who will assist anybody with disabilities.
- 2) No smoking is allowed inside the building or in the car park area. This is for practical reasons as well as complying with the law regarding smoking in the work place. The main house is largely of wooden construction and therefore a fire risk.
- 3) There are smoke alarms in every room. If you hear one going off at any time please leave the building at once - do not assume it is a false alarm. Do not attempt to put the fire out and do not try to retrieve personal belongings. Make your way calmly to the Assembly point where the Fire Marshall will check everyone is out of the building. **The Assembly Point** is on the pavement opposite the entrance, in front of the car dealer's premises. Exercise caution crossing the road as it can be quite busy even at night.
- 4) Fire extinguishers are placed at strategic points around both buildings but are strictly for dealing with the most minor of incidents. Do not attempt to tackle a serious fire.
- 5) There is no telephone at Hoppers but if you should need to call the Fire Service or other emergency services do so when the building has evacuated.
- 6) Candles may only be used in the context of worship and only in the Chapel. Use responsibly. Extinguish them immediately that the worship is finished.
