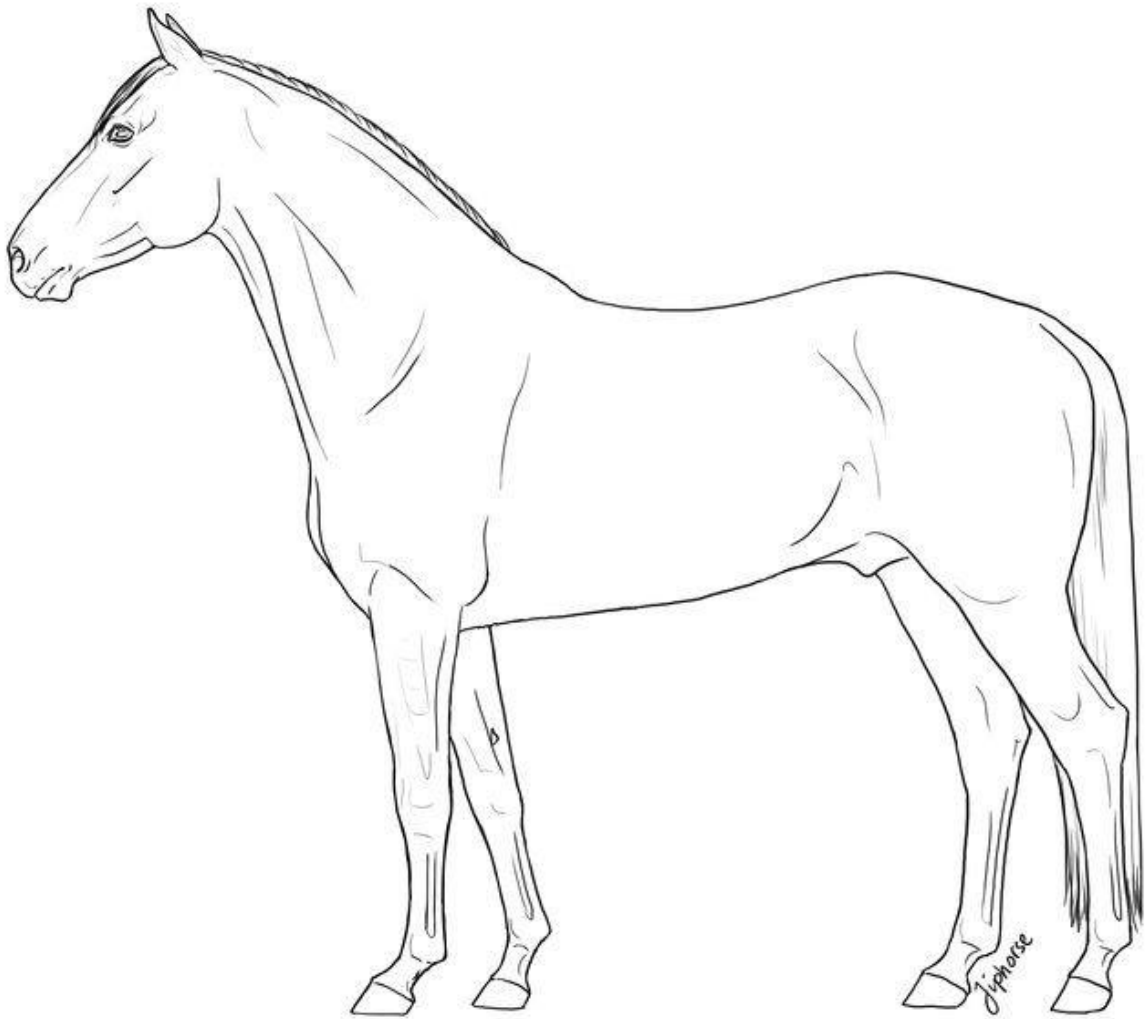

Breeds of Horse 1 Activity 2

These horses are most commonly black, bay, brown, grey or roan. The average height at the withers of grown stallions is about 17.2hh. Weight ranges from 850-1100kg.

The head of this breed is long and lean, with large eyes, set on a neck that is slightly arched and long in proportion to the body. The shoulder is deep and wide, the chest wide, the back muscular and short, and the hindquarters long and wide. Not too much feathering is to occur on the legs, and the hair is fine, straight and silky.

They have an enormous capacity for pulling weight. At an exhibition in 1924, a pair of them pulled a load equal to 50 tons.

These ponies are hardy and strong, in part because the breed developed in the harsh conditions of the Shetland Isles. In appearance they have small heads, widely spaced eyes, and small and alert ears. The original breed has a short, muscular neck, a compact, stocky body, short, strong legs and a shorter than normal cannon bone in relation to its size. A short broad back and a deep girth are universal characteristics, as is its springy stride. They have long thick manes and tails and dense double winter coats to withstand harsh weather.

They can be almost every colour but are mainly black, chestnut, bay, grey, palomino, dun, roan, cremello and silver dapple.
