The location for our courses to train equestrian experts is situated at the doorstep of Fischland, on one of the largest and most modern equestrian farms at the Baltic Sea.

## The Equestrian Expert

The training course for equestrian experts is a certified qualification similar to that for a fully qualified groom (Pferdewirt), combined with the knowledge of horse breeding, horse keeping and the services around the horses and their riders. In addition to the knowhow about horses and the comprehensive service for interested customers our training will also impart equestrian knowledge and relevant qualities (for Reitpass\* and Reitabzeichen\*\*) as well as knowhow in the management of breeding, of insemination and of event organisation. Our aim is to prepare you thoroughly for a job in the horse branch. Make use of this opportunity to acquire a new professional qualification!



## The Contents of the Course

The course will last for 8 months and is designed for full-time education. It consists of the two parts 'theory' (1/4 [a quarter] of the time) and 'practice' (3/4 [three quarters] of the time) and comprises the following learning fields:

- Field 1: Safety Regulations and Accident Prevention
- Field 2: Keeping, Caring for and Feeding of Horses
- Field 3: Moving the Horses and Working with them (including Reitpass\*/Reitabzeichen\*\*of level 5)
- Field 4: Reproduction, Horse Breeding and Management of Insemination
- Field 5: Services around Horses and their Riders
- Field 6: Management of Event Organisation
- Field 7: Usage of Gadgets and Machinery, Equipment and Accessories
- Field 8: Professional Knowhow

\* - a German certificate for riders who are able to ride in the open country and in streets

\*\* - a German badge showing the level of equestrian skills the rider has acquired

## Completion of the Course

The successful completion of the course will enable you to work in any enterprise of horse husbandry.

You will acquire the following qualifications:

- Equestrian Expert, approved by KTL
- FN1 badges: Basispass\*\*\* /Reitpass\* /Reitabzeichen\*\* level 5 (RA 5)
- Management Certificate of Horse Breeding and Insemination
- Management Certificate of Equestrian Event Organisation
