Bad Honnef situated between the
Rhine River and the Nature Park
„Siebengebirge“ is located south of
Bonn. Because of its fine location,
the city is blessed with a very mild
climate. The surrounding hills shelter
from harsh winds and the Rhine River
is responsible for balanced tempera-
tures. In Bad Honnefs parks and gar-
dens exotic trees may be found and
the central located market square
reminds of a mediterranean piazza
when having a coffee there.

The most famous district of Bad
Honnef is Rhöndorf. In this small
village, the first Chancellor of the
Bundesrepublik Deutschland, Kon-
rad Adenauer, had his residence.
Nowadays the residential house and
gardens are part of a very worth
seeing museum and exhibition: the
„Stiftung Bundeskanzler-Adenauer-
Haus“.

Rommersdorf-Bondorf



Rommersdorf with its half timbered
houses from the 17th and 18th cen-
tury is a very picturesque district. This
little part of the city was able to pre-
serve its original character until today.

houses, the various offers of the local
gastronomy attract visitors under
shady trees in summer. When stroll-
ing through the adjacent pedestrian
zone a high-quality range of small
and individual shops is provided.

Selhof



The grown district of Selhof has re-
tained its village character. Originally
characterized by viticulture and agri-
cultural use, today people like to live
in this tranquil district. The Simrock-
Haus "Parzival" at Menzenberg is also
worth seeing (may only be visited
from outside).

Aegidienberg



The district of Aegidienberg with 13
villages is located above the Rhine
valley. It spreads on the eastern foot-
hills of the Siebengebirge and is
connected to Bad Honnef through
Schmelztal with its sweeping wood-
lands. „Aegidienberger“ is not only the
denomination of the inhabitants of
the villages but it is also the name
of a horse breed that is bred in the
local stud.

The historic forest cemetery, where Konrad Adenauer's and Peter Scholl-Latour's graves are located, fascinates with its mystic, tranquil atmosphere in the middle of mother nature.

Hohenhonner: The sanatorium, built in French palace architecture in 1891/1892, was a pulmonary hospital and sanatorium until 1979. Today a rehabilitation center for people with disabilities is situated here.

Kurhaus: Bad Honnef - formerly also called „Nizza am Rhein“ („Nice on the Rhine“) - looks back at a long past as a healing and recreation resort. The newly renovated Kurhaus from 1907, once the center of spa activities, now shines again in fresh glory and has become a prestigious event location.

Welcome to Bad Honnef

Bad Honnef is situated in a beautiful setting between the Rhine River and Siebenberg Nature Park.

Explore the beautiful districts **Rhöndorf**, **Rommersdorf-Bondorf** and **Selhof** or visit the "Stiftung Bundeskanzler Adenauer Haus" with its museum about the first German Chancellor.

Discover beautiful parks, the promenade along the Rhine or just let your mind wander on tranquil **Grafenwerth Island**.

Popular hiking destinations in the Siebenberg are **Löwenburg**, **Drachenfels** and **Ölberg**, all of them with refreshment possibilities. **Breiberg**, **Himmerich** and **Leyberg** offer spectacular views while having a small picnic. These hiking destinations are easily reachable from all districts, free parking lots are offered in Rhöndorf (Ziepchensplatz), at the Rheinpromenade (train stop Line 66) und Schmelztalstraße L 144 (Hiking Parking Lots).

Marked access to **Rheinsteig** may be found in Rhöndorf (Distance from train station / parking lot approx. 10 min) and at the Youth Hostel (Jugendherberge) in Selhof (Distance from train station / parking lot approx. 30 min). You may also combine a hiking tour with a boat trip on the Rhine or with a train ride to the access points of Rheinsteig e.g. in Unkel (return to Bad Honnef approx. 3,5 hrs.) or in Linz (return to Bad Honnef approx. 6,5 hrs).

A popular excursion destination on the opposite side of Rhine River is **Rolandsbogen**. We also recommend a visit to the nearby **Arp-Museum** in the historic Rolandseck train station or a visit at **Rolandseck Wildlife Park**. Bike Tours along the Rhine are also very popular, there are possibilities to explore the Ahr Valley or you decide to go north to Bonn and the Sieg Valley. Or why not taking a leisurely stroll along the Rhine Promenade to Königswinter (north) or on rather narrow paths to Unkel (south)?
