Welcome to the MTT December Newsletter.

Year 4 Classes – Wednesday 4.45pm – 5.45pm or Thursday 4.00pm – 5.00pm – Chalk Hill, Bushey

MTT offer Year 4 classes at our hall in Bushey. By attending the Year 4 classes, students are exposed to the format, content and formality of being tutored. Results have shown that those students who start in Year 4 can accelerate their learning when moving to year 5 by 2 to 3 months.

Year 5 Extended Class – Wednesday 5.00pm – 6.30pm – Queens' School (New Class)

Extended class aimed at students wanting extra study time.

Year 5 Accelerated Class – Tuesday 5.15pm – 6.30pm – Queens' School.

Accelerated Learning classes are aimed at students who show a higher-than-average aptitude for both VR & Maths. This class works at a higher level and at a greater pace.

Whilst our primary aim is to support SW Herts Test (GL Assessment) our events can also benefit other 11+ preparation.

First events – It's never too early to start but it can be too late.

We recommend that students attend an event early in the year to overcome their nerves and help them understand why they are being tutored. Importantly it allows our trained staff to observe how students manage the test environment to feedback to parents. This can be important when registering with the SW Herts Consortium if your child requires additional support.

Additional Requirements (Special Consideration)

If your child usually receives extra time or special intervention in class, you are required to let the SW Herts Consortium know when registering in April. You will need to provide a supporting letter from your Head teacher or SENDco. (SW Herts registration opens April 2026 <https://www.swhertsschools.org.uk/>)

If you are unsure if your child needs special consideration, MTT will be offering this service (Separate Room, Readers, Extra time) at some of the events over the year. (subject to availability). By attending events early, the MTT experienced team are able to monitor, observe and provide you with early feedback.
