### [Year 6 - School Application – Deadline 31<sup>st</sup> Oct.](#)

After all the arduous work and preparation, you now need to select and apply to the schools you wish to be considered for. School websites have their historic results as a guide, these are not pass / fail, they are there as a guide.

The schools are not aware of the order you rank the schools, so please don't worry, select the schools you wish to apply for. Please note that on March 1<sup>st</sup>, if you don't get your first choice you will be placed on to the continued interest list, and as places are accepted or rejected this means further places become available.

You will need to apply in the Herts County Council website (or where you pay your council tax if outside Herts) You may also need to fill in a Supplementary Information Form (SIF) for each school you are applying to. Please check the school's website for up to date information.

Once you've selected your 4 schools (6 in Harrow and Hillington) you will be notified on the 1<sup>st</sup> March, national school allocations day which school you have been given.

### [Year 5 – SW Herts Consortium Tests – Registration. 9<sup>th</sup> April 2024.](#)

For those families with Year 5 children, please don't worry. The registration portal will open on or near the 9<sup>th</sup> April 2024 (dates to be confirmed)

### Year 4 Classes – MTT Hall, Chalk Hill (£27.50 Standard 1 hour class)

For those with children in Year 4 wishing to start tutoring, we have two classes available.

- **Wednesday 4.00pm – 5.00pm**
- **Thursday 5.15pm – 6.15pm**

By attending the Year 4 classes, students are exposed to the format, content and formality of being tutored, offering good foundations for Year 5. We've found that those students who start in Year 4 accelerate their learning when moving to year 5 by 2 to 3 months.

### Year 5 Classes – MTT Hall, Chalk Hill - (£27.50 Standard 1 hour class)

For those with children in Year 5 wishing to join a class, we have the following options:

- **Tuesday 4.45pm – 5.45pm**
- **Thursday 4.00pm – 5.00pm**

### Year 5 Extended Class – Wednesday 5pm – 6.30 pm – Queens School 6<sup>th</sup> Form (£35.50)

We are pleased to offer this extended class for those children wanting extra study time. This proved to be an extremely beneficial class for students last year,

### Year 5 Accelerated Class – Thursday 5pm – 6.30 pm – Queens School 6<sup>th</sup> Form (£35.50)

Accelerated Learning classes are aimed at students who show a higher than average aptitude for both VR & Maths. This class will work at a higher level and at a greater pace.

### Trial Lessons
