## SW Herts 11+ Registration closes 14th June.

If parents want their child (Yr 5) to take the SW Herts, 11+ tests, you will need to register on the SW Herts website.

### Mock Tests June - Aug - Queens' school

#### **VR & Maths**

GL Assessment multiple choice format giving children a real exam experience. Papers are scanned and parents receive detailed reports, showing scores, ranking and test analysis and peer comparisons. We run 10 different mock tests.



#### Don't loose points for bad marks

MTT are pleased to offer a real test experience with multiple choice answer sheets requiring students to put a horizontal line. For some this may appear easy, however students may lose points for poorly marked papers. MTT highlight bad marks as part of the Paper Review.



#### Paper Reviews – Learning from mistakes

Paper Reviews offer a constructive opportunity for students to review their papers, to revisit and learn from their mistakes working with their parents.

Book a paper review to help your child refine, learn and improve.



#### Special consideration

To support children who may need or have Special Consideration requirements, such as a smaller room, extra time, we are offering 4 opportunities for students to experience sitting a Mock Test in the smaller room environment with extra time and special considerations considered. #### **SW Herts Mock Music Test**

Mock Music Tests provide an introduction to sitting the SW Herts Music exam. (Stage 1.)

Unlike the academic test, children need to learn to listen careful, and not be distracted by the environment or others taking the test. Only by sitting a mock test in an exam hall offers this valued experience.



#### **Queens Sports Test**

To keep your options open you may wish to book a Queens Sport Awareness session. These sessions allow students to try each of the activities. They are supervised by staff with experience of the actual sports test and students receive a training plan to take away.
