SW Herts 11+ Registration is now open, closes 5th June.

If you want your child (Yr 5) to take the SW Herts, 11+ tests you will need to register on the SW Herts website.

Don't lose points for bad marks!

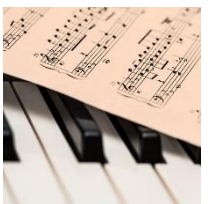

Paper Reviews offer a constructive opportunity for students to review their papers, to learn from their mistakes working with their parents.

SW Herts Mock Music Test (Next Music test 16th May)

Mock Music Tests provide an introduction to sitting the SW Herts Music exam. (Stage 1.) Unlike the academic test, children need to learn to listen careful, and not be distracted by the environment or others taking the test. Only by sitting a mock test in an exam hall offers this valued experience.
