

Types of Bouquet



BIEDERMEIER BOUQUET

Flowers are tightly arranged in a circular format with different types of flowers in each circle.



COMPOSITE

Made up of different petals or buds wired together on a single stem so that it looks like an enormous flower.



NOSEGAY BOUQUET

A compact cluster of flowers, with more foliage than flowers. Wrapped tight and cut to one uniform length. Also known as tussie mussie.



BASKET BOUQUET

Flowers are arranged in a shallow basket. Garden flowers are often used for this bouquet.



POSY BOUQUET

It is round and small and is arranged tightly and neatly.



HOOP BOUQUET

Combining flowers and greenery this bouquet is then wrapped and then a ribbon of choice is added.



HAND TIED BOUQUET

This is type of posy bouquet that is loosely tied and gives of a more natural feel. It can also be held with one hand.



ARM SHEAF BOUQUET

This bouquet displays long stemmed flowers and foliage that is carried cradled in the arms. Also known as presentation bouquet.



CASCADE BOUQUET

The flowers in this bouquet descent in a cascading manner. It is designed to spill gracefully over the brides hands.



POMANDER

A flower covered ball shape tied with a ribbon.
