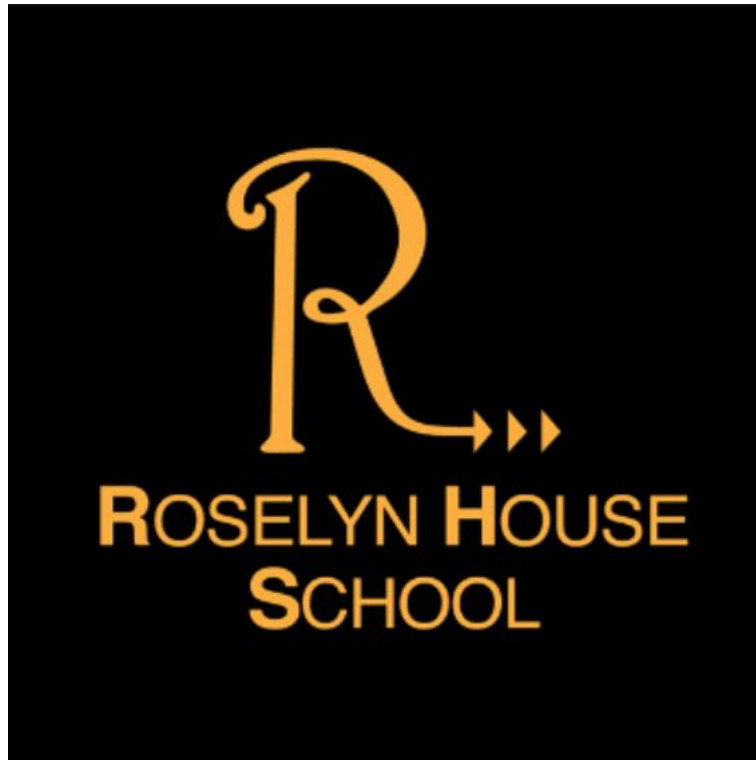

COOKIE POLICY

What are Cookies?

We ask that you read this cookie policy carefully as it contains important information on and our use of cookies on our website.

Cookies are small data files that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. Cookies are widely used by online service providers to help build a profile of users. They are also used to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. Some of this data will be aggregated or statistical, which means that we will not be able to identify you individually.

You can set your browser not to accept cookies and the websites below explain how to remove cookies from your browser. However, some of our website features may not function as a result.

Types of Cookies

The cookies we place on your device fall into the following categories:

- **Targeting cookies**—also known as advertising cookies, these cookies are used to deliver adverts more relevant to you and your interests. They are also used to limit the number of times you see an advertisement on our website and help measure the effectiveness of the advertising campaign. They are usually placed by advertising networks with the website operator's permission. They remember that you have visited a website and this information is shared with other organisations such as advertisers.
- **Session cookies**—these allow our website to link your actions during a particular browser session. These expire each time you close your browser and do not remain on your device afterwards
- **Persistent cookies**—these are stored on your device in between browser sessions. These allow your preferences or actions across our website to be remembered. These will remain on your device until they expire, or you delete them from your cache
- **Strictly necessary cookies**—these cookies are essential for you to be able to navigate our website and use its features. Without these cookies, the services you have asked for could not be provided

- **Performance cookies**—these cookies collect information about how you use our website, eg which pages you go to most often. These cookies do not collect personally identifiable information about you. All information collected by these cookies is aggregated and anonymous, and is only used to improve how our website works
- **Functionality cookies**—these cookies allow our website to remember the choices you make (such as your user name, language, last action and search preferences) and provide enhanced, more personal features. The information collected by these cookies is anonymous and cannot track your browsing activity on other websites

DIY_SB www.roselynhouseschool.co.uk	This cookie is being set in relation to our content management.
DIYAppServer Cdn.website-start.de	This cookie is being set in relation to our content management.
cookiefirst-id www.roselynhouseschool.co.uk	This cookie contains your unique ID so CookieFirst can identify unique visitors to this website.
cookiefirst-consent App.cookiefirst.com	This cookie saves your cookie preferences for this website. You can change these or withdraw your consent easily.
ADVERTISING: YSC .youtube.com	Registers a unique ID to keep statistics of what videos from YouTube the user has seen.
VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE .youtube.com	This cookie allows Youtube to check for bandwidth usage.

CONSENT .youtube.com	Third party cookies. They provide certain features of Google and may store certain preferences according to usage patterns and personalize the ads that appear in Google searches.
NID .translatepa.googleapis.com	The NID cookie contains a unique ID Google uses to remember your preferences and other information, such as your preferred language, your most recent searches, your previous interactions with an advertiser's ads or search results, and your visits to an advertiser's website. This helps us show you customized ads on Google.

How we use your Cookies

The School may request cookies to be set on your computer or device. Cookies are used to let us know when you visit our website, how you interact with us and to make your experience using the school website better for you. The cookies we collect will differ depending on what you are looking at on our website. You are able to adapt your cookie preferences, but by blocking certain types of cookie it may mean that your experience on the website is impacted.

Consent to use Cookies

We will ask for your permission (consent) to place cookies or other similar technologies on your device, except where these are essential for us to provide you with a service that you have requested (eg to enable you to put items in your shopping basket and use our check-out process).

There is a notice on our home page which describes how we use cookies and requests your consent to place cookies on your device.

How to turn off Cookies

If you do not want to accept cookies, you can change your browser settings so that cookies are not accepted. If you do this, please be aware that you may lose some of the functionality of this website.
