We were contacted by the owner of the Three Crows pub as staff were feeling on edge or frightened when locking up at night.

There were reports from unexplainable noises, an empty can being tossed with no one near it, gas pump valves being turned off but no one would claim responsibility for it and the last straw for them was the bar hatch door which closed of its own accord in front of the bar manager.

We could not replicate the noises as it was not physically possible.

It was described to us that the creaking of the toilet door could be heard as it closed but the door was already closed, so it seemed impossible. We tried closing other doors to replicate the sound but were unsuccessful.

We had positioned an empty can and asked aloud that if there was anyone present that was capable of moving the can could they please do so. The can was in a locked off area and was not disturbed by anything supernatural.

We set up a camera filming the bar hatch to see if we could capture the door moving.

We did not record the door moving but to our surprise the camera had been switched off entirely. It still had plenty of battery in it but at 1 hour 42 minutes it was powered off. There is no sign of anyone doing this as we were all in the function suite at the time.

Lastly, we tried to establish what was happening with the gas pump valves being turned off.

The valves themselves were secure enough; they were tight enough to lock so there did not appear to be any physical problem with the pumps.

We attempted to record a few EVP recordings as we all had sensed the presence of a male spirit watching us. Alec said that he felt the man's name was Frank but the spirit wasn't forthcoming with information so it was hard to give the owner and staff much to go on sadly.

There were some responses on the recorder but they were not too clear to establish anything much so further analysis will need to be carried out with these recordings in an attempt to establish if anything was recorded of a paranormal nature.
