1st Visit

First if all I would like to express a big thank you to Lisa, the owner of the house which we were privileged enough to investigate. Your kind hospitality was greatly appreciated.

Lisa had asked us along to investigate her property as her family and friends were experiencing a variety of paranormal activity in their home.

Instances stretched from hearing a baby crying in the house but not particular to any one room.

There were also various sightings reported of orbs encountered throughout the house both on camera and by the naked eye.

The family dogs would seemingly react and bark at an empty space in different rooms and occasions.

There were also reports of unusual battery drainage on household appliances and light bulbs blowing out.

Finally the Study room was reported to be unusually cold compared to other rooms in the house.

Lisa felt that there were perhaps quite a few spirits present in her house and was keen to try and find out a little more about them. Especially the crying baby as she and her family felt more tormented by the sobbing. Present from our team on the investigation were Trisha (sensitive to spirit), Julie (Tech), Rob (Camera man), Nigel (Camera man) and myself (Team leader).

Household members paricipating in the investigation were, Lisa, Kelly, and Bobby.

We split into two teams.

Julie took Rob and Trisha upstairs to see if they could contact any spirits that would be willing to communicate with us.

They found the majority of the spiritual activity in the master bedroom and the en-suite.

Trisha reported that a couple of spirits were present but appeared to be having a conversation.

The team attempted some EVP experiments and appeared to get some responses so they left a recorder running to see if we could eaves drop in on the conversation that spirit were having.

There does appear to be anomalous recordings captured, but this has still to be reviewed as the recorder was left for quite a length of time.

Hopefully we will manage to record some kind of conversation between spirits. That would be very interesting indeed.

Nigel and I took the readings downstairs.
Initially there was not much to speak of in the way of unusual EMF readings but what we did experience that was very unusual was intense battery drain from our equipment.

Cameras and lights were not holding a charge for any great length of time despite being fully charged prior to leaving to head to the investigation.

We attempted to capture this on film but failed as the camera which was recording the light trigger object lost power prior to the actual light after it.

Nigel works with cameras as a profession and he could not explain the level of intense battery drain we were experiencing.

With the exception if one camera, this phenomena affected all of our other equipment. I ensured that witnesses recorded the camera batteries as being fully charged when starting to use them so no suspicion of fault could be laid at my door for not charging the equipment properly.

The witnesses were satisfied at the time that everything looked to be above board, we just could simply not explain rationally why the drainage was so intense.

Both teams met up at break time and discussed our findings at this point then proceeded to investigate the Study, which was the coldest room in the house.

Temperatures in there did fluctuate quite wildly from time to time so I thought I would check the windows for any drafts etc using the thermal camera.

We did not detect anything unusual, that was until we had turned to investigate a corner of the room which Julie had identified earlier as having an unusual energy about it. As we turned the thermal camera to record the temperature in this area, something black moved towards the camera and eclipsed it.

I could get no visual readings from anywhere in the room at that point so I turned the camera on Rob to ensure that it was still operational and I was picking up his thermal reading, just nothing around us. Very strange indeed. I tried changing the settings on the camera with no luck at all.

Incidentally, this was at the same point that the light trigger object had went out.

Coincidence? Perhaps, but fascinating all the same.

By this time it was getting into the early hours of the morning so we finished the investigation.
